Policy on Conflict Minerals

Analytic Systems Ware supports the position of the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC), and the Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI) which aims to prevent the use of certain “Conflict Minerals” that directly or indirectly finance or benefit the armed group in The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries as defined in the Act.

Analytic Systems is committed in avoiding the use of conflict minerals from Congo or adjoining countries, in line with the EICC’s Electronic Industry Code of Conduct.

Based upon information provided by our suppliers, Analytic Systems Ware does not knowingly use parts containing metals derived from the Conflict Region in our products. Suppliers of parts, containing specifically Tin, used in the manufacture of power conversion products are asked to demonstrate that they understand and support EICC-GeSI actions and the company will not knowingly procure specified metals that originate from the Conflict Region. Suppliers are instructed to provide written evidence of due diligence documenting that raw materials used to produce tin supplied to or used in the manufacture of Analytic Systems Power Conversion products, do not originate from mining or smelters operating in the Conflict Region. Due diligence from each supplier must include, where applicable, completion of the EICC-GeSI Conflict Minerals reporting template.

If Analytic Systems Ware becomes aware of a supplier whose supply chain includes metals from a conflict source, Analytic Systems will take the appropriate actions to remedy the situation.
